3. General Provisions

The competition regulations, the legal system and the anti-doping regulations of the German Swimming Association (DSV) apply in their current version.

Swimmers with a minimum age of 20 years (cut-off date 31.12.2024) who have the right to start for a club or a starting community whose clubs belong to a member association of the DSV or World Aquatics (formerly FINA) are eligible to participate.

All competitions are decisions. The seeding of the races takes place according to the registration times, regardless of gender and age group. The ranking is separated by gender and age group.

All competitions will be held according to the one-start rule according to §125 (6) WB.

The event was approved by the Rhine-Wupper Swimming District (SB-RW) in the North Rhine-Westphalia Swimming Association (SV NRW).

4. Referee-court

Referee panel is provided by the SB-RW in key positions.

Clubs from North Rhine-Westphalia (LSB 17) provide one referee from three participants, two judges from six participants and three judges from 15 participants.

Other judges from all clubs are welcome to carry out the event.

Please enter by the registration deadline.

5. Entries

Each participant has the opportunity to register for up to five individual competitions.

The registration of the individual competitions is only possible online on the website www.duessel-cup.de. The registration deadline is March 10, 2024, 11:59 p.m.

The team captain of the respective club will report the relays informally by e-mail to swim@duessel-cup.de by 19 March 2023. Changes to the relay participants can still be made until March 23, 2024, 10:00 a.m.

With their registration, the swimmers assure that they have the right to start for the club, that they have paid for the annual license prescribed by § 22 (2) WB-AT and that they have proven their sports health by means of a medical certificate that is not older than one year on the day of the competition.

By submitting the registration, the clubs confirm that their registered athletes are in possession of a valid certificate of fitness for sport in accordance with WB AT § 8. Furthermore, the club assures that the active members of the registered team have the right to start for the club and that the annual licence prescribed by WB AT § 16 para. 2 (f) has been paid.

The registration fee must be paid by the registration deadline via the payment methods specified in the registration portal. Reports will only take effect after receipt of the registration fee.

In WK 5 (400 m freestyle), the 25 participants will be considered in the order in which the valid registrations are received.

6. Entry fee

Participation in the competition (per participant): 45,00 €

7. Registration Result and Protocol

The registration result and protocol will be published on the website www.duessel-cup.de shortly after the registration deadline/end of the event and the possibility of downloading will be announced by e-mail (if an e-mail address has been provided).

In addition, the results will be displayed in the swimming pool shortly after the end of the respective competitions as well as

8. Awards

Medals for places 1 – 3 within the age groups

The medals will be handed over at the medal table in the swimming pool (pick-up); no medals will be forwarded.

9. Age group classification

The age group classification is made according to §152 WB (MS). The cut-off date for age determination is 31 December of the year in which the swimmer reaches the respective age.

For individual competitions, the following age group classification applies:

For the relay competition "MIXED Special" (WK 16) the following age group classification applies:

For the age group classification in relay competitions, the age in whole years of life of the relay members is summarized. The age groups of the individual swimmers are not to be taken into account here.

German age group records in relay competitions may not be recognized if a swimmer in the age group 20 was involved.

In the mixed relays, 2 women and 2 men start in any order.

In the Mixed Special Relays (WK 16) at least 3 women and 3 men will start in any order.

10. Inclusiveness

Participants with an identity outside of "male" and "female" can participate in the swimming tournament as "diverse" (d). However, the rules of the World Aquatics (formerly FINA) and the DSV do not allow a competition with reporting of the performances to the federations. These participants (d) start in their own competition outside the official association ranking, alternatively the gender male/female can be decided after consultation with the organizer, so that a registration of the performances is possible.

11. Privacy policy

By registering, the participant agrees to the privacy policy of Düssel-Cup GbR, which can be found at <https://duessel-cup.de/datenschutz/>.

By participating in the competition, the participant also agrees to the electronic storage, processing and disclosure of personal data relevant to the competition, stating name, club name, age, class, competition name, start number and start time. This processing is carried out in accordance with Article 6 (1) (b) GDPR. By participating in the competition, you also consent to the processing and publication of the start and result lists as well as any photos of the competition and the award ceremony in notices, on the Internet, in social media and in other publications of the SB-RW. Participants can object to the storage, processing and use of their personal data and request deletion. The consequences result from the competition regulations of the DSV. The lists of results that have already been published will not be changed in the event of an objection to publication, they will remain in place.
